YOU WIELD THE POWER OF YOUR OWN DESTINY

I apologize for the inconvenience, but this was completely out of my control. A lot of changes have been taking place with my publishing company, and I may be forced to switch to a new printing company. My online sales should not be affected, but I'll update on this more later.

I'm going to try and think of different content to add into my newsletters. The question form on my website hasn't been used much lately, and readers I ask for feedback usually ask spoiler-type questions, so they would not be suitable for the newsletter list. Most people who are signed up for the list are all caught up on the series, but I have to be mindful of people using the newsletter archive and reading back on anything they've missed. Q2: WHERE DID THE TITLE OF YOUR SERIES AND BOOKS COME FROM? HOW DID YOU THINK OF THEM?

I had the title picked from the very beginning: *A Night's Passage*. The story was heavily invested in the idea of the Passage of time and the day and night cycle. The Passage part was half the passing of the night: half the definition of Passage; literally meaning the Night's Story. *A Morning's Arrival* was another play on this night/day cycle. With the natural progression of night turning into morning, that is where the sequel picks up. The title also plays into the details and plot of the novel, but you'll have to read it to find out the real meaning.

The series didn't actually become official until I started working on the second book. At first, I had no idea how I was going to name the series as a whole. But then I came up with it, pulling from the words in my story to form it. I kept writing that Isabel and Sam were: 'wielding' the Stones, and I just made them Wielders. Since they were the Stones of Power, Samuel and Isabel were the destined: Wielders of Power. Hence, the series name was born.

Q3: WHAT WAS THE FIRST STORY YOU EVER WROTE?

Back in early elementary school, we had a chance in our library class to write our own books and get them bound and made into hardback copies. Only a few inches wide and tall, the folded pages held my first 'book'. "All About Dogs" was this first story. It was more non-fiction than a novel, but with my 1st grade writing style, it is hard to tell. It also included artist illustrations of the dogs I was explaining about. Later in the year, my second 'book' was made. "All About Fish" followed the same style as

Q1: WILL YOU EVER WRITE ANOTHER BOOK FOR A COMPLETELY DIFFERENT SERIES?

This related to a previous question of how many books for the *Wielders of Power* I would write, and I answered I would write as much about this series as possible. Because this was the first fiction series I have ever made, I'm really attached to the characters and the world I have created. It's easy to write about something or someone I feel like I know a lot about. Writing another series from scratch would be extremely difficult, but I think one day I'll go for it. This is definitely a long term writing goal of mine, perhaps several plus years into the future, but I do want to try something new. I feel like my writing style and character mannerisms would reflect the characters I've made in the *Wielders of Power*, but I would try to write something much different. I would most likely still be in the Young Adult audience, writing some kind of action/mystery/suspense novel, just a plot that is very different from what I've made here.
