Wielders of Power: Volume 3

As mentioned previously, I have started writing the third book in my series. This newsletter will give you a closer look into the development of my latest book. Some things to expect, some of my own thoughts on its structure, and I'll include quotes or scenes that I've already written. I'll be adding more of them in future newsletters as well.

Just to clarify, **nothing** in the newsletter will spoil anything more than what can be read on the back cover of *A Night's Passage*. As I am about to explain, Volume 3 in the series is going to be slightly different than my previous two.

WIELDERS OF POWER SERIES: SEQUENCE OVERVIEW

Chronologically, The Wielders of Power Series follows this order: *A Night's Passage*, then *A Morning's Arrival*, then *Volume 3*. However, with the way this book will be written, a new reader to the series could technically read Volume 3, then *A Night's Passage*, followed by *A Morning's Arrival*. Book 3 will be within the same series, but switching protagonists. While reading Volume 1 & 2 of the Wielders of Power Series will give you more information and background knowledge on the contents and plot of Volume 3, its story will be able to blend into the series nicely, if read in the: 3-1-2 order. My newest book will be covering Isabel Gosteu's origin story.

“WHY STRUCTURE THE SERIES THIS WAY?”

From very early on, I intended to write origin stories for many of the characters I created. The first one that came to mind, was Isabel's story. She has many mysteries that surround her, and many questions about who she really is. She had survived this long, but her survival was an entire story that was barely scratched upon in *A Night's Passage*. Isabel would reveal in dialogue that many things in the past have defined her, but she is unable to remember what they are. So, why am I writing my third book so that it could chronologically fit by 1-2-3, or 3-1-2? Story wise, it is viable. While some of the events in Volume 3 can be anticipated by reading the previous two novels, many of this story is untold, and will connect multiple events together by being a 'prequel' to *A Night's Passage*. Many questions of Isabel's mystery will be answered, all the while being a brand-new adventure with perils around every turn. I want to write more of my characters' origin stories, but not all will follow a 'sequenced order'. Book 3 is special in the fact that while it doesn't

'continue' the main story, it will tie everything together while bringing its own unique personality. Other books on some of my other characters could be "stand-alones" or "spin-offs" in my series.

"WHEN TO EXPECT VOLUME 3"

I mentioned before that *A Morning's Arrival* was started before *A Night's Passage* was even published. I was too excited to see where my story was going, I needed to keep writing new material. While this head-start on writing the second novel was an enormous help in getting Book 1 and 2 released one year apart from each other, it also has a downside. More than half my book was completed at this point last year. With the updates to Volume 1, and the publishing process of Volume 2, my third installment in the series was put on hold. While I've made a lot of progress already, I'm no where near the same spot I was at this point last year. With that being the case, there is a small chance that I'll make my annual publishing around Christmas-time. My "safe" estimation for the arrival of Volume 3 will be Summer of 2019. While I plan to have it completed much earlier than this, it **will** be out by next summer, at the latest.
